This Privacy Policy is designed to tell you about our practices regarding collection, management, use, and disclosure of information that you may voluntarily provide to this site or to us through an electronic or mobile device such as a cell phone or tablet (collectively, mobile device). Please be sure to read this entire Privacy Policy before using or submitting information to this site or through a mobile device. This site is intended for use by residents of the United States. Personal information provided through mail, email, phone call, text message, social media, or otherwise (other than through a Noven web site) is also protected under this Privacy Policy.

Your Consent

By using this site, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy and the Terms of Use. Whenever you submit information to this site, through a mobile device, or otherwise, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of that information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, please do not use our sites and please do not submit any personal information to us through a mobile device or otherwise.

About Children

Information You Provide and Personally Identifiable Information

You can view most of our content anonymously. Passive Information Collection

As you navigate through this site, certain anonymous information can be passively collected (that is, gathered without you actively providing the information) using various technologies, such as cookies, Internet tags or web beacons, and navigational data collection (log files, server logs, clickstream). Your Internet browser automatically transmits to this site some of this anonymous information, such as the URL of the website you just came from and the Internet Protocol (IP) address and the browser version your computer is currently using. "Internet tags" (also known as single-pixel GIFs, clear GIFs, invisible GIFs, and 1-by-1 GIFs) are smaller than cookies and tell the website server information such as the IP address and browser type related to the visitor's computer. Tags may be placed both on online advertisements that

bring people to the site and on different pages of the site. Such tags indicate how many times a page is opened and which information is consulted.

"Navigational data" (log files, server logs, and clickstream data) are used for system management, to improve the content of the site, market research purposes, and to communicate information to visitors.

Use and Disclosure of Information

Except as otherwise stated, we may use information collected via this site, through a mobile device, or otherwise, to improve the content of our site, to customize the site to your preferences, to communicate information to you (if you have requested it), for our marketing and research purposes, and for any other purpose specified in this Privacy Policy.
